

### Sat 16th May 2009 v Stone Home

The Third XI game due to take place at Stone, was abandoned without a ball being bowled with each team taking 5 points.

### Sat 23rd May 2009 v West Malvern

The Third XI had a thrilling last ball win in their game against West Malvern to take maximum points. Having been asked to bat first, Old Hill Third's scored a total of 247 for 7 wickets (45 overs) thanks to a magnificent century partnership between Mike Hingley 103 and Zak O'Neill 64. West Malvern replied with 212 all out (45) with Dave Jones bowling beautifully and taking 5 for 45. Old Hill Third XI 24 points; West Malvern Third XI 7 points. Old Hill won by 35 runs.

### Sat 30th May 2009 v Vine Away

The Third XI also had a poor weekend losing to Vine by 7 wickets. Batting first, Old Hill quickly lost their first 6 batsmen and it was left to Karl Jones 37, to guide the visitors to a reasonably respectable total of 153 for 9 wickets off their 45 overs. Vine then quickly scored the necessary runs for the loss of 3 batsmen to win the match by 7 wickets. Vine 20 points, Old Hill 5 points.

### Sat 13th June 2009 v Bewdley Away

The Third XI played some very good cricket in their game away at Bewdley to register a creditable winning draw. Put in to bat, Old Hill scored 250 for 7 wickets with Sam Perruzza scoring 50 runs, Imran Mateen 44, Zak O'Neill 42 and George Derham 33. Bewdley batting second were hanging on for a draw at 223 for 9 wickets with George Derham taking 5 wickets for 51 runs and Sam Perruzza 2 for 35. Old Hill 16 points, Bewdley 9 points (45 overs).

### Sat 20th June 2009 v Cleobury Mortimer Away

The Third XI's match against Cleobury Mortimer ended in a draw after the visitors totalled an imposing score of 241 for 5 wickets off their 45 overs thanks mainly to a century from B Griffiths, 134 not out. In spite of a sterling effort from Steve Derham (52), they could only manage 171 for 7 wickets in a rain affected reply to end with a losing draw having had their overs reduced because of the weather. Old Hill 7 points, Cleobury Mortimer 15 points. Match drawn.

### Sat 27th June 2009 v Knighton-on-Teme Away

The Third XI fielded a weakened team away to Knighton-on-Teme and although the youngsters tried very hard they lost by 50 runs. Batting first, Knighton scored 192 - 6 wickets off 45 overs, James Hunt 2 - 21, Dave Jones 2 - 33. In reply, Old Hill were all out for 142 off 37 overs with Captain Maurice Whyte scoring 50. Old Hill 3 points Knighton-on-Teme 24 points.

### Sat 4th July 2009 v Harvington Away

The Third XI lost their game at title chasing Harvington by 9 wickets with a lacklustre display. Batting first, Old Hill scored 187 - 8 wickets off their 45 overs thanks to good contributions from Dan Jones 46, James Hunt 36 and Reece Shilvock 24. The home side then batted very

well to total 191 - 1 wicket off 29 overs to cruise to victory. Old Hill 3 points, Harvington 24 points.

### Sat 11th July 2009 v Chainwire Home (Evesham)

Old Hill (5 points) v Chainwire (5 points), match abandoned.

The Third XI game against Chainwire was abandoned due to heavy overnight rain without a ball being bowled.

### Sat 18th July 2009 v Stone Away

Old Hill 170 (24 points), Stone 98 (4 points). Old Hill won by 72 runs.

The Third XI were put in to bat by hosts Stone in their game at Shenstone and responded with a good all round display of batting highlighted by James Hunt (75) scoring his first half century for Old Hill, well backed up by Karl Jones to guide the visitors to a total of 170 all out off 44 overs. When Stone batted, Dave Jones and Dan Jones (4 - 12) produced a hostile opening spell of bowling for Old Hill backed up by Jared Daniels (2 - 21) and Mitch Jeffery (2 - 17) to skittle their opponents for less than 100 runs, to gain a maximum of 24 points for a superb display.

### Sat 25th July 2009 v West Malvern Away

Old Hill 178 (6 points) lost to West Malvern 181 - 8 (20 points) by 2 wickets.

Old Hill Third XI chose to bat first in their match at West Malvern and scored 178 all out off 43 overs with Reece Shilvock scoring 54 and Joe Thorn 51 compiling his first half century for the Club at this level. The match was in the balance right to the last over with the home side taking advantage of two extra overs at their disposal to reach 181 - 8 wickets (46.3 overs) with Dan Jones taking 3 for 27. West Malvern won by 2 wickets.

### Sat 1st Aug 2009 v Vine Home (Stone)

Old Hill (5 points) Vine (5 points). Match abandoned.

The Third XI "home" game due to take place at Stone CC against second placed Vine was abandoned on the previous evening due to a waterlogged ground.

### Sat 8th Aug 2009 v Brintons Away

Old Hill 221 - 8 (24 points) beat Brintons 140 (4 points) by 121 runs.

Old Hill Third XI had an excellent away win at Brintons with a very good all round performance. Batting first, the visitors scored 221 - 8 wickets off their 45 overs with young Jared Daniels top scoring with 82 runs. The home side were then bowled out for just 140 runs in 32 overs to give Old Hill victory by 121 runs with James Hunt taking 4 - 21 and George Derham 2 - 27, the major wicket takers.

### Sat 15th Aug 2009 v Bewdley Away

A very good all round performance by Old Hill Third XI gave them victory at home to Bewdley. The visitors took first knock and were bowled out for 84 runs in 22.4 overs with George Derham taking 4 - 24. ### Sat 22nd Aug 2009 v Cleobury Mortimer Away

Old Hill 182 - 8 (7 points) drew with Cleobury Mortimer 191 - 6 (14 points).

Cleobury Mortimer batted first in their match at home to Old Hill Third XI and ended their 45 overs on 191 - 6 wickets with Dan Jones taking 3 - 15. The visitors batted well in reply thanks to Steve Derham (55) and Tom Rook (34) but it was not quite enough as they ended 9 runs short of their target and ended on 182 - 8 wickets off 45 overs for a losing draw.

### Sat 29th Aug 2009 v Knighton-on-Teme Away

Old Hill 70 - 3 (20 points) beat Knighton-on-Teme 66 (1 point) by 7 wickets.

Old Hill Third XI won the toss and put the home side in to bat and thanks to some magnificent bowling by Dave Jones 5 - 13, George Derham 2 - 16 and Steve Derham 2 - 0, Knighton were rushed out for 66 runs. The visitors then scored the necessary runs for the loss of 3 wickets with George Derham following up his excellent bowling performance with 20 runs in Old Hill's total of 70 - 3 wickets and take 20 points for victory by 7 wickets.
